Associated with wind.

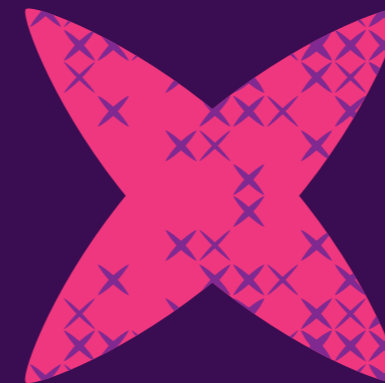
The winds of change that come with new students and the new year. Support staff are the stars that keep on shining through it all.

Associated with fresh water and creatures that live in rivers, streams and lakes.

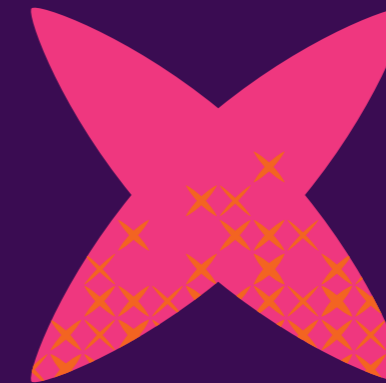
The cleansing purity of fresh water reminds us that each day is a new day for our tamariki.

We, support staff, are the 'mother' of our school. We come together to celebrate and reflect. We look forward to what could be for support staff!



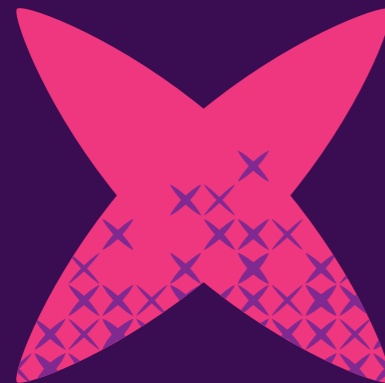
Tupuānuku
