 do as the cornerstone of our education system
- The day is a chance to highlight the work that tumuaki / principals do for our schools, tamariki and communities, which often goes unsung
- It's a chance to recognise tumuaki / principals and their leadership
- It acknowledges that tumuaki | principals often prioritise the wellbeing of their students, staff and community at the expense of their own
- Tumuaki | principals have an essential role within communities throughout Aotearoa ensuring all aspects of schooling are taken care of so that all tamariki / rangatahi benefit
- Te Rā o Tumeke Tumuaki shows we are committed to listening to tumuaki /principals and standing beside them as they address the issues that need to be resolved to enable our tamariki | rangatahi to thrive
- The day shows we are standing in solidarity with tumuaki | principals and are committed to making their professional lives manageable and sustainable.
